PREPARATION

FACTOID	The exact origin of the Sidecar is unclear, but it is thought to have been invented around the end of World War I in either London or Paris. The drink was directly named for the motorcycle attachment, the drink appears in literature as early as 1907. The Ritz Hotel in Paris claims origin of the drink.
1	Rub the rim of a cocktail glass with the Lemon Wedge and dip the wet rim into Sugar to coat. In a shaker with Crushed Ice, add in the Cointreau, Lemon Juice and Cognac. Shake well and then strain into the glass. Garnish with the Lemon Wedge and one or two Cherries.
